1. Mike Dudley called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM
2. Fr. Huber led us in prayer.
3. Motion to approve this month's agenda and the August 2020 meeting minutes was made by Denise and seconded by Gary.
4. Committee Reports:
 - A. Finance and Administration – Fr. Huber reported that the income is up compared to last year and how supportive the parishioners have been in difficult circumstances. Fr. Huber will write a short letter that will accompany the “reminder” statement that will go out after the first of November.
 - B. Board of Education – Fr. was unable to attend last weeks meeting.
 - C. Community Life and Social Concerns – Income from the Harvesfest Raffle was \$7,937.00. Harvestfest donations were \$4,645.00. The total amount will be sent to the D & L under Rosary Society account.
 - D. Spiritual Growth and Liturgy – Meeting is scheduled for next week. Main discussion will be the number of Masses for Christmas and Holy Days, Communal Penance and if we will have music.
 - E. Building and Grounds: The Parish Council accepted the bid to repair the downspouts on the north end of church, Gary 1st and Mike 2nd, motion approved. Rich Earles, insurance adjustor for Archdiocese was here for the annual walk through and found several areas that need attention. The buildings and grounds committee will take care of these jobs. The main one being the structural integrity of the wall along side of the street. Brian brought in an engineer that said patching the weak areas would be enough but the council felt they wanted to do a more thorough and aesthetic job. Janet will check with Alma Huck on the defibrillator in church. Gary will check with a contractor about the repair on the steps. Gary will also compare wording on bids for replacing the deck/handicap entrance to the rectory.
 - F. Deanery Council –Fr. Huber said that the Deanery will meet tomorrow.

6. New Business: Covered under Committee Reports.

7. Father Huber's Comments: Fr. Huber spoke about the schedule for Feast Days and Christmas Masses. Fr. Huber also spoke about his Sabbatical.
